FAQs

1) What is the Power to Play grant program?

Power to Play is an annual athletic and arts grant program for high schools across Alabama that have an overall financial need.

2) What qualifies as an overall financial need?

Schools with 50 percent or more of their student body eligible for free and reduced-price meals are invited to apply.

3) What has changed about the Power to Play grant program for 2016?

New to Power to Play in 2016 are grants for arts programs. Eighteen grants will be awarded to arts programs and 18 grants will be awarded to athletics programs.

There is no public voting this year. Grants will be selected by an internal committee, which is the same process for Alabama Power Foundation's other programs. Rather than categorizing grant hopefuls by size classification (1A–6A/7A), all applications will be reviewed together. The grant selection committee will consider school size during the review process.

4) Can the same school apply for grants in both categories?

Yes, schools are eligible to apply for both arts and athletics grants.

5) When will schools be able to apply for Power to Play grants?

Applications will open on Monday, Sept. 19 and will close on Friday, Oct. 28.

6) To qualify, do the schools that apply have to be in the Alabama Power service territory?

Yes. Schools need to be in the Alabama Power service territory to qualify.
